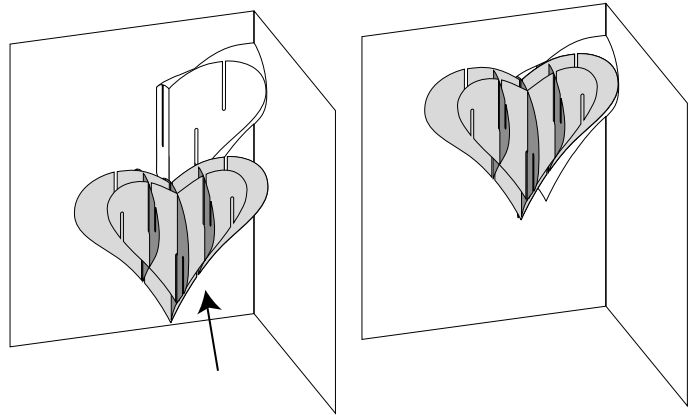
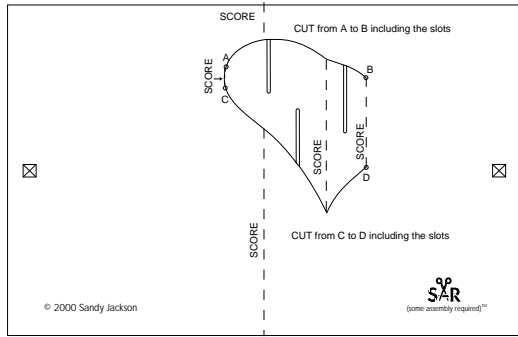
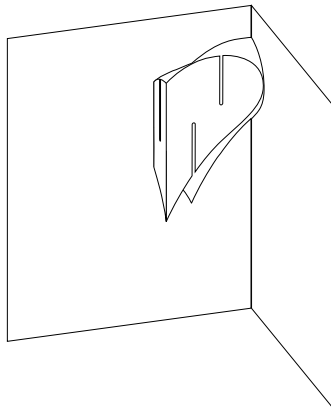


Heart Card

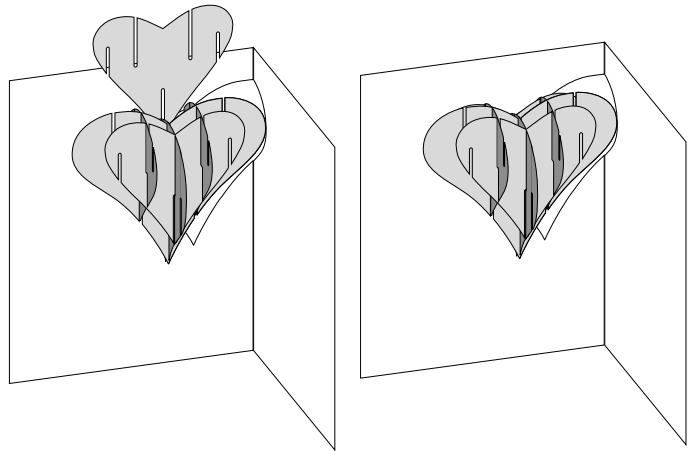


Print the card pattern on cover stock (80 lb. is good), grain long, and cut in half. The lower half is shown above. Score the dashed lines, cut along the solid lines and carefully fold the scored lines. All are mountain folds except the line in the middle of the heart shape which is a valley fold.

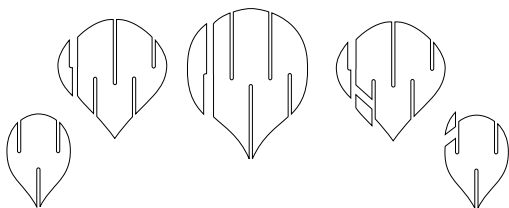


The inside of the card should be plain. The printing should be showing on the **outside** of the card.

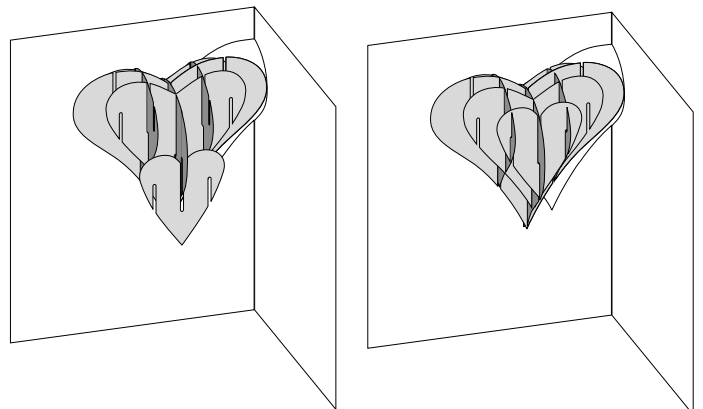
Holding the teardrop on the right, slide the assembly onto the card making sure that the large heart sits right up against the card and that the large teardrop is right against the outside of the left portion of the folded out section. You will be **reusing** the teardrop's middle slot.



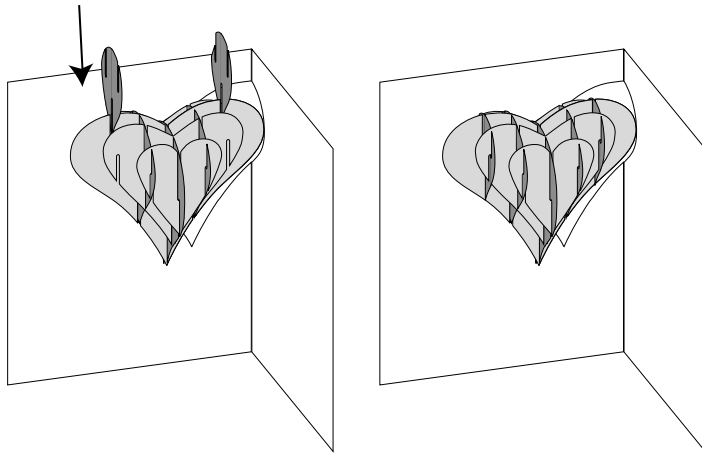
Pinching the large teardrop and the card together, lower the other medium heart piece over the two matching slots behind the center of the large teardrop. This is just the normal assembly method, but you must be sure to catch the two layers of paper. Attach the heart to the medium teardrop on the left and then to the teardrop on the right.



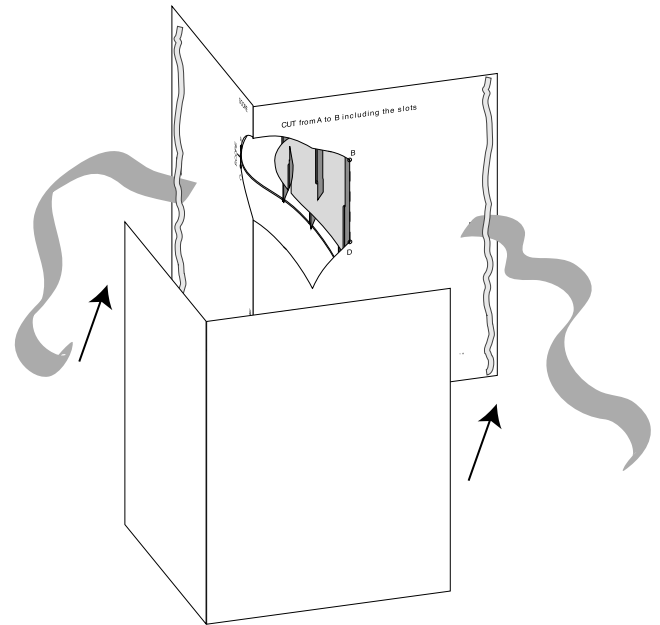
Modify a set of teardrops as shown. All of the cut portions go to the back of the heart. The pieces with the shortened slots go on the right hand side of the heart. Using the modified teardrops, assemble a medium heart through step 4 of the heart assembly instructions.



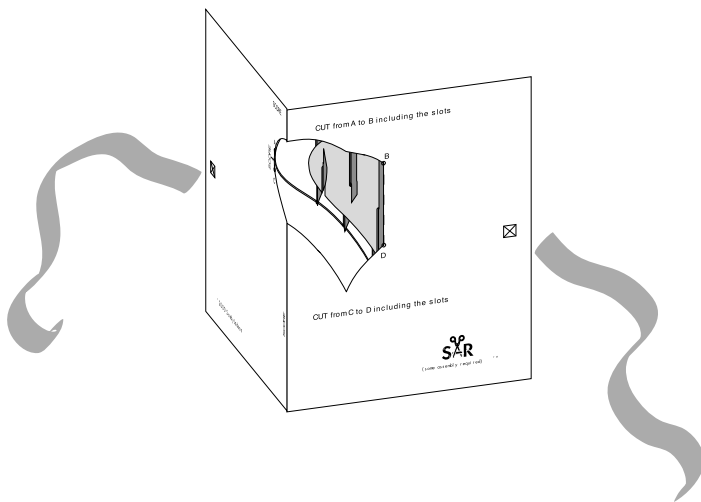
Attach a small heart on the front side.



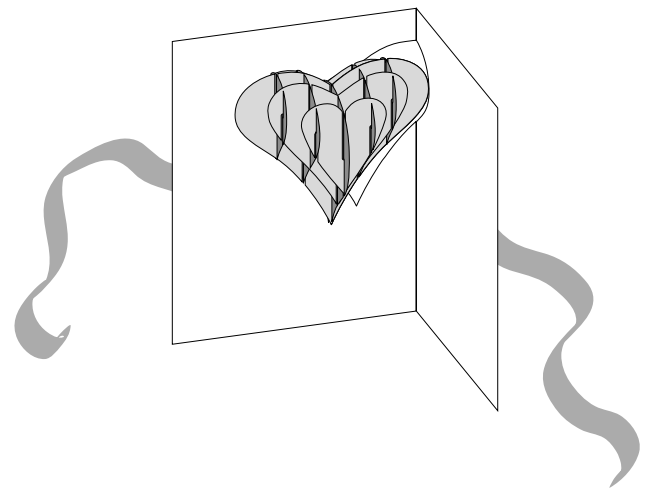
Attach the two small teardrops, making sure to put the modified one on the right hand side of the heart assembly.



Turn it so that the printed line faces the first part of the card assembly. There is a section of the dashed line that is missing. This area goes right behind the heart assembly. Glue the side edges of the card together.

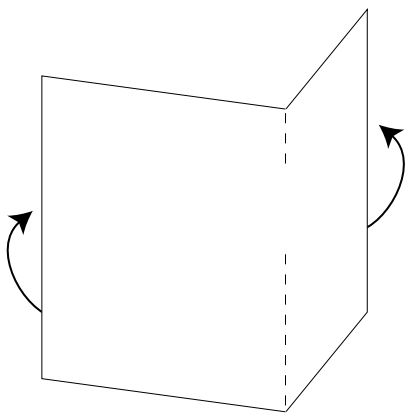


Using the small squares as a guide, glue ribbons on the outside of the card.



You can put a little glue behind the right lobe of the large heart piece to keep it from slipping down. The outside of the card should be decorated before assembly.

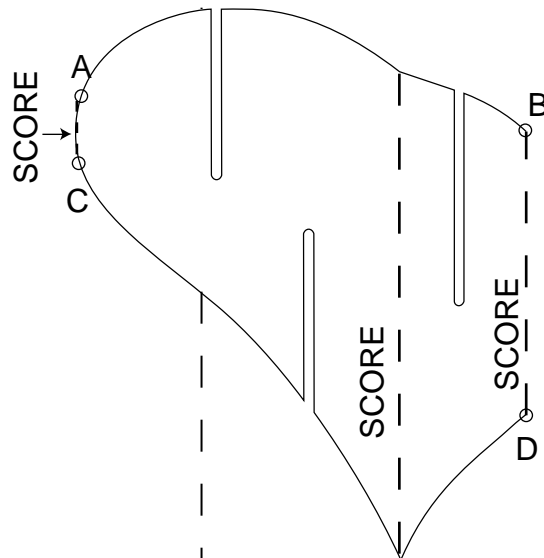
