

# Barbara's Bunny

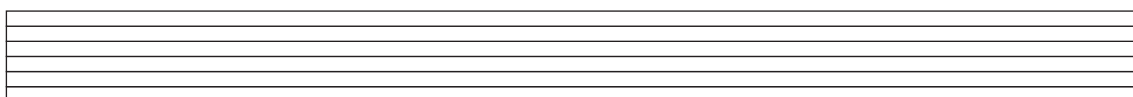
This wonderful design was created by Barbara Christmann. She has used similar techniques to make other whimsical pear heads.

For this project you will need an assembled pear from either a Pair of Pears in Champagne or Mocca, or a white pear made with the 3D Pear Stamp Set.

Print this page on white cover or card stock. Cut out a whole ear, the pink part of the other ear, teeth, nose and tabs, and eyes. Leaving the holes from these pieces makes it easier to trace the small shapes. Assemble the eyes before gluing them on.



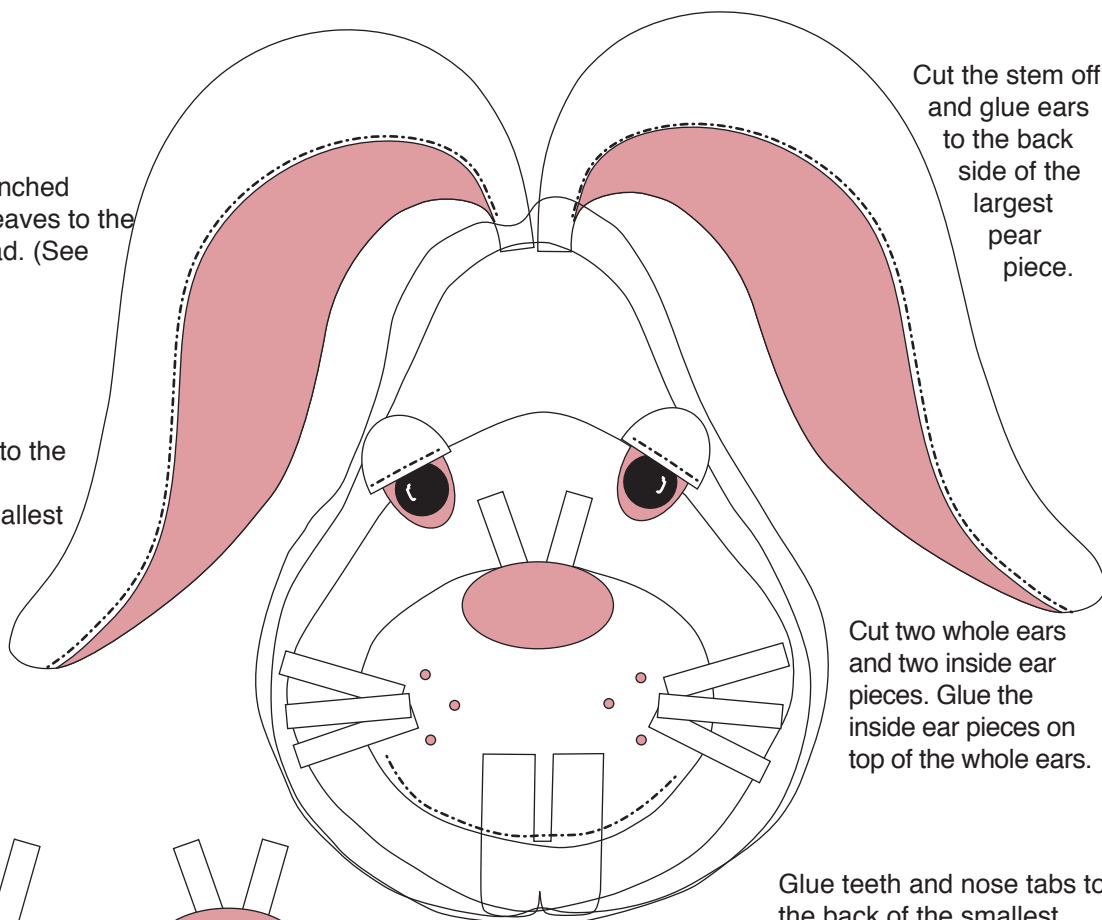
Cut 6 strips for whiskers across the grain and wrap each around a pencil to curl. Glue to the front (or the back) of the smallest piece making sure that they pass through the slots of the cross pieces.



Add some punched flowers and leaves to the top of the head. (See picture.)

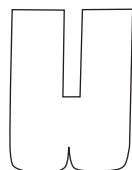
Glue eyes to the front of the second smallest piece.

Cut the stem off and glue ears to the back side of the largest pear piece.

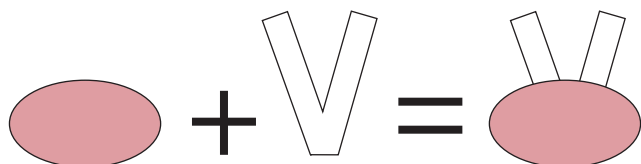


Cut two whole ears and two inside ear pieces. Glue the inside ear pieces on top of the whole ears.

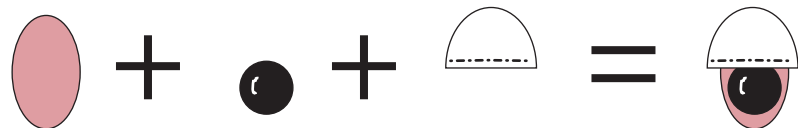
Glue teeth and nose tabs to the back of the smallest piece and add a smile.
